



IL YMCA Statewide 2Ball Tournament FAQs

- Are teams allowed to compete at more than one event/YMCA?
 - Yes, teams can compete at multiple locations.
 - We encourage all Y's to charge a fee.
- Can Y's secure their own local sponsorships?
 - Yes. Ys are welcome to secure local sponsorship.
- Can singles register and be teamed with another single?
 - No individual registrations accepted. Participants must register as part of a two-person team.
- Age at state –must be age 14 or under at state competition.
 - Participants must be in the appropriate age group as of the state final dates (March 7, 2026 for girls, March 14, 2026 for boys). High school students are not eligible to participate.
- What might cause a participant or team to be disqualified?
 - The only statewide restriction is age as of March 2026.
 - Disqualification due to unacceptable behavior/violation of rules is up to the individual YMCA hosting a local tournament.
- How do we verify correct age/grade level to ensure our competitors who qualify for state are in the right age group?
 - Winning team members will be asked to verify age with a birth certificate.
- Do we have local Y's utilize their own waiver for participation?
 - YMCA's will use their own waiver for local tournaments.
 - The IHSA will likely have an additional waiver for those participating during state championships.
