

YMCA 2-Ball Competition Recommended Program Outline

Program Deadlines

- Local Competition Results due to reporting committee no later than February 2, 2026
 - o Program must run by February 1, 2026
 - o Submit scores: https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/26IL2Ball
 - Girls IHSA State Championships are March 7, 2026 in Normal, IL.
 - o Top two teams in each age division will compete during half-time of IHSA games.
- Boys IHSA State Championships are March 14, 2026 in Champaign, IL.
 - o Top Two Teams in each age division will compete during half-time of IHSA games.

Marketing & Registration

- Registration and Marketing open a minimum of 4 weeks prior to local competition
- Age divisions for shop competition:
 - o 9U division
 - o 10U division
 - 12U division
 - 14U division (high school students are not eligible to compete)
- Recommendation: schedule 1-1.5 hours for each division to come compete. For example...
 - o 9U division will run 8am-9am
 - o 10U division will run 9am-10am

OR

- o 9U division will run 8am-9:30am
- 10U division will run 9:30am-11am
- All competition results are due no later than 5pm February 2, 2026

Program Design

- Review attached rules and court layout diagram
 - o Run program exactly as recommended in these documents
 - Recommend having two courts with shot layouts
- Minimum staffing requirement: 3 Staff 1 site lead, 2 officials
- Site Lead:
 - o Oversee the program
 - Open registration and send out marketing
 - Reserve court time
 - Each YMCA will supply their own floor markers. 9-inch nonslip floor markers, available on Amazon 12 markers for \$19.99
 - Answer questions from program participants
 - Collect data
 - Submit data:

- Highest scoring in each age group for Girls
- Highest scoring in each age group for Boys
- Total number of teams participating
- Court officials:
 - o Track points based on shot location
 - Track time
 - o Track participant foot placement for legal shot
- Basketball Hoops and Basketball size requirements
 - o Hoops will all be set at a standard 10-foot rim
 - o All Girls divisions will use a 28.5-inch ball size 6 ball
 - o Boys 9U will use a 28.5-inch ball size 6 ball
 - o Boys 10U and up will use 29.5-inch ball size 7
