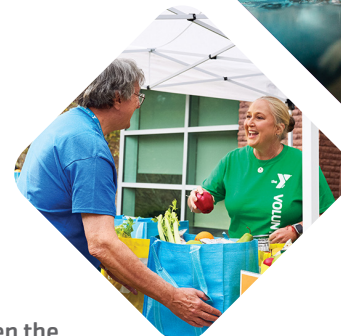

The Illinois State Alliance of YMCAs and its 44 YMCA association partners strengthen the foundations of community through youth development, healthy living and social responsibility.

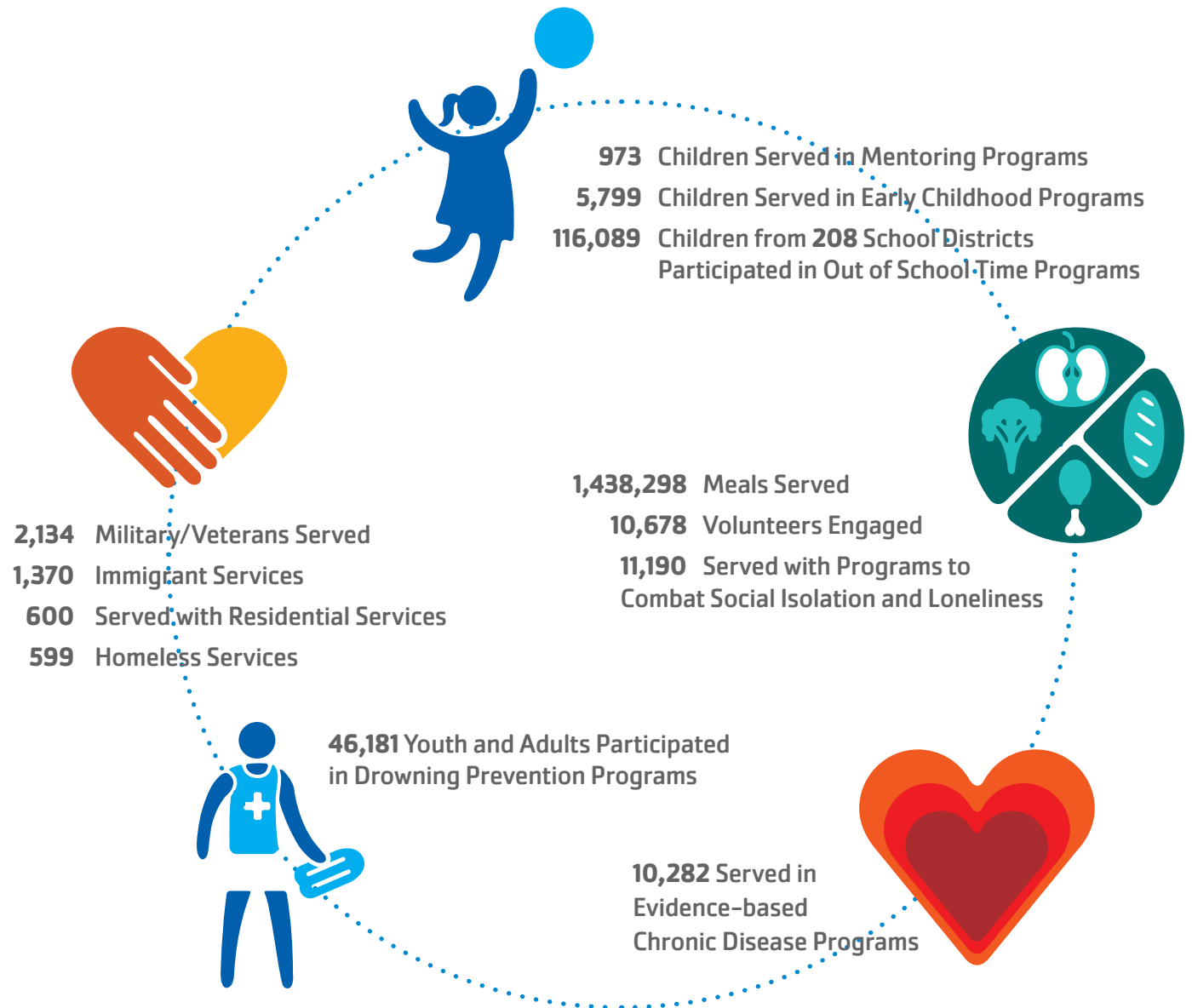

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT – YMCAs supported youth and families through safe and enriching out-of-school-time programs, strategic partnerships, and adaptive programs.

HEALTHY LIVING – YMCAs prioritized healthy behaviors by welcoming the community into wellness centers, promoting drowning prevention and supporting those battling chronic diseases by offering evidence based programming.

SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY – YMCAs stepped up to meet the unique needs of their communities: vaccination education and clinics, blood drives, mental health services, food distribution, tax preparation, clothing drives, emergency immigrant housing and services, support of adults with developmental disabilities, and more.

SAFETY NOW, SKILLS FOR LIFE

Drowning Prevention Grant



Every year in our country, approximately 900 children die from drowning, and thousands more are hospitalized as a result of non-fatal drownings. Drowning is the second leading cause of unintentional injury for 5- to 14-year-old youth and disproportionately affects children of color. 64% of African American and 45% of Hispanic/Latino children are unable to swim, compared to 40% of Caucasian children. The National Autism Association reports that, from 2009-2011, accidental drowning accounted for approximately 90 percent of total U.S. deaths reported in children with autism ages 14 and younger due to wandering or elopement. Because most of these tragic deaths are preventable, drowning prevention is a priority for YMCA of the USA and YMCAs across the country.

In 2025, Illinois YMCAs delivered drowning prevention curriculum to 4,558 children free of charge through the **Safety Now, Skills for Life** statewide drowning prevention program. This initiative was funded through a Congressionally Directed Spending allocation in the amount of \$400,000. Initiated by Senator Tammy Duckworth, funds for this initiative were administered through the Department of Education. 100% of this program was financed with these funds.
